## **Little Christmas Wreath**

#### **Materials**

small amount of sport weight yarn (#2) and a matching hook yarn needle scissors stitch marker decoration materials

I used Schachenmayr Catania in colour 0412 Khaki and a 2,75 mm hook

## Stitches used / Abbreviations (US terms)

| ch    | chain(s)            | FPsc | front post single crochet |
|-------|---------------------|------|---------------------------|
| sl st | slip stitch         | BL   | back loop                 |
| SC    | single crochet      | FL   | front loop                |
| hdc   | half double crochet | Rnd  | round                     |
| dc    | double crochet      |      |                           |

## **Pattern**

Chain 10 and slip-stitch to first chain to form a ring

| Round 1 | Ch2 (counts as first hdc), 19 hdc, sl st to first stitch [20 hdc]  |
|---------|--|
| Round 2 | ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same stitch, dc in next hdc,<br>*2 dc in next hdc, dc in next hdc - repeat around |
|         | sl st to BL of first stitch [30 dc]  |

Round 3a this round is worked in back loops of rnd 2 stitches only

Tip: it might be helpful to mark the front loop of the first stitch with a stitch marker \*ch 2 and sl st in next BL, ch 1 and sl st in next BL, sl st in next BL repeat around, the last sl st is worked in the marked FL of Rnd 2

**Round 3b** this round is worked in front loops of rnd 2 stitches only

\*ch1 and sl st in next FL, ch2 and sl st in next FL, sl st in next FL - repeat

around, sl st in first stitch, fasten off

### Round 4

this round is worked around the stitches of round 2 join with a slip-stitch around the post of any dc, \*ch 2, FPsc around next dc - repeat around, ch 2 and sl st in first stitch, fasten off and weave in the ends



# **Finishing**
