Hooked on Häkelmaschen



Granny Square Day 2024



Materials

DK / worsted weight (# 3) yarn and appropriate hook size
yarn needle, scissors

My samples are made with

Hobbii Rainbow Cotton 8/6, 100 % Cotton (105 m / 50 g) and a 3,75 mm hook

Colourway 1

Colour A - # 49, Peach
Colour B - # 47, Dark Old Rose

Colourway 2

Colour A - # 65, Apricot
Colour B - # 12, Volcano Gray

Finished Size

about 10 cm / 4 inch

Skill Level

beginning intermediate

Stitches and abbreviations used are listed on page 4.



Pattern

Round 1

Colour A

*start in a Magic Ring
ch3 (counts as first dc), 1dc, ch2;
[3dc, ch2] 3 times; 1 dc; invisible join, fasten off*

stitch count: 12 dc, 4 ch2-sps

Note: from now on start each round with a standing stitch and end with an invisible join

Round 2

Colour B

*start in any ch2-sp
(2 dc, ch2, 3 dc) in ch2-sp, ch 1; skip to next ch2-sp;
[(3 dc, ch2, 3 dc) in ch2-sp, ch 1; skip to next ch2-sp] 3 times;
1dc in first ch2-sp where the first two dc of the rnd are already placed; fasten off*

stitch count: 24 dc, 4 ch2-sps, 4 ch1-sps

Round 3

Colour A

*Note: all ext tr and dtr in this round are worked in the ch2-sps of round 1
For better readability, their exact placement is not explained in detail in the
following instructions, so please have a look at the Special Stitches section on pages 4 and 5 first*

*start in any ch2-sp
(2 dc, ch1, ext tr in ch2-sp of rnd 1, ch1, 3dc) in ch2-sp, ch1; skip next 3 dc; dtr to the
left, dc in ch1 sp, dtr to the right, ch1, skip next 3 dc;
[(3dc, ch1, ext tr, ch1, 3dc) in ch2-sp, ch1, skip next 3 dc; dtr to the left, dc in ch1
sp, dtr to the right, ch1, skip next 3 dc] 3 times; 1 dc in ch2-sp where the first 2 dc of
the rnd are already placed; fasten off*

stitch count: 28 dc, 4 ext tr, 4 dtr left, 4 dtr right, 16 ch1-sps

Round 4

Colour B

*start in any ch1-sp before an ext tr
[(3 dc) in ch1-sp, ch2, skip ext-tr, (3dc) in next ch1-sp; skip next dc, dc in next 2 sts
and ch1-sp; shallow Bpdc around next 3 sts, dc in next ch1-sp and in next 3 sts] 4
times; fasten off*

stitch count: 56 dc, 12 shallow BPdc, 4 ch2-sps



Finishing

I recommend blocking the square so that the stitches open up a little.

Abbreviations and stitches used (US Terms)

sp(s)	space(s)	rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)	dc	double crochet
ch	chain	dtr	double treble crochet
ext tr	extended treble crochet		
shallow Bpdc	Shallow back post double crochet		
()	Stitches within brackets are worked in the same stitch or space	[]	Instructions within parentheses are repeated as many times as directed

Special Stitches

Shallow Bpdc

a shallow Bpdc is worked very similar to a regular Bpdc. Instead of around the post of a stitch, a Shallow Bpdc is worked directly under the "V" (top loops).

ext tr

How an ext tr is worked is explained [here](#)

The ext tr in round 3 is worked in the ch2-sp of rnd 1. It is placed in the middle of the two 3dc groups (between the 3rd and 4th dc) of rnd 2



dtr to the left

How a dtr is worked is explained [here](#)

In rnd 3 the first dtr (dtr to the left) is worked in the ch2-sp of rnd 1. It is placed to the left of the 3dc group that is located directly under the ch1-sp of rnd 2

dtr to the right

How a dtr is worked is explained [here](#)

In rnd 3 the second dtr (dtr to the right) is also worked in the ch2-sp of rnd 1 but behind the first dtr. It is placed to the right of the 3dc group that is located directly under the ch1-sp of rnd 2
